



# COVID-19 Vaccines for People with Medicare



**What does it cost?** You pay nothing for the vaccine!



**Where do I get it?** COVID-19 vaccines are available at pharmacies, clinics, doctors' offices, hospitals, or even in the home. Find a vaccine near you at [www.vaccines.gov](http://www.vaccines.gov).



**What do I bring?** Bring your red, white, and blue Medicare card to your appointment, even if you have a Medicare Advantage Plan. Otherwise, you may be asked for your Social Security number to verify you're on Medicare.



**Already vaccinated?** Boosters are recommended for most people, and especially for older adults. Speak with your doctor if you have questions.

**Undecided?** Older adults are highly at risk from COVID-19. Most Americans age 65 and older are vaccinated. Learn more about the vaccine's effectiveness at [www.cdc.gov/coronavirus](http://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus).
